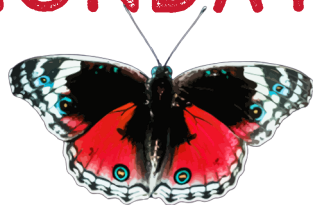

Fencing is a workout for both the body and mind; sometimes being referred to as a mental chess game. Each session concludes with a practice tournament and Awards Ceremony. Please note that parental consent is required prior to actual use of fencing equipment; all students will need a parent/guardian to fully complete and sign IndySabre's waiver form. En garde!

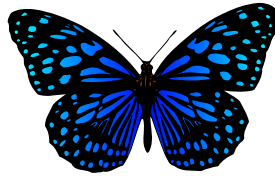

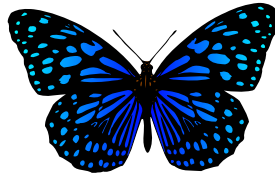
