Resource Specialist Program

Resource Specialist Program Coordinator

We are looking for a dynamic individual to serve an integral role in our program. The RSP Coordinator oversees all the Tier 1 and Tier 2 students in a grade level, and also works directly with the RSP Director and other RSP Coordinators on all aspects of the Resource Specialist Program including:

- Managing a caseload of between 20-40 students
 - Meet with families, create goals for students, implement interventions and provide support to assist them in reaching those goals and provide.
 - Implement ISPs
 - Coordinate with instructors on ISP goals and in-class accommodations
- Creating and implementing grade level curriculum for RSP study skills course
- Serving as the main teacher for 2 RSP POD courses
- Managing RSP aids during RSP POD sessions
- Collaborating with other RSP coordinators on RSP policies and protocols
- Possibly Teaching an RSP specific Literature course for freshman or sophomores in the program
- Understanding and implementing the mission of Archbishop Riordan High School and the RSP Program

- Extensive experience working with students with learning differences
