Media



Television stations and newspapers may stop by and photograph students for various reasons and in various settings including in the classroom, during activities, for a station's "file footage" (no close-ups are taken at this time), or to interview students about topics relating to elementary, middle and high schools (close-ups can be taken at this time).

PTA and Teachers



Parent Teachers Association (PTA) and teachers do take random photos of students to use in the school's yearbook and in their classrooms.

Some parents like to take pictures of their child's class, which may also include a picture of your child. Some of the pictures or videos taken may be used in the school, on the District or schools' website, in printed materials the District distributes, in local newspapers, or during local television broadcasts.

Our goal is to protect your family's privacy and safety. Before publishing any pictures or videos, we ask your permission to do so. For your child's protection, if you do not give permission, we will have an area designated for them to sit whenever the media is present.
