PLEASE NOTE School drill reporting will close on Sept. 15 in accordance with the Act. Once you have submitted the schools drill schedule, you MUST complete the drill on the date and time you have committed to. Public Act 12 of 2014 only allows for a drill date to be changed when a scheduled drill could not occur due to conditions not within the control of school authorities such as severe storms, fires, epidemics, utility power unavailability, water or sewer failure, or a health condition AS DEFINED BY THE COUNTY OR STATE HEALTH AUTHORNTIES. In this situation, the drill must be rescheduled to occur within 10 school days after the original scheduled date of the cancelled drill act. A schedule change notification to the District notifies the County Emergency Management Coordinator of the above events it still must be conducted within 10 school days of your originally scheduled drill.
