Position Title: Assistant Professor of Accounting

Wingate, a comprehensive, independent and growing university, serves more than 3,600 students in North Carolina. The candidate will be expected to effectively teach 3 or 4 courses per semester in the undergraduate and Master of Accounting (MAC) programs. A strong commitment to excellent teaching is essential. Additional expectations include advising undergraduate accounting students, serving on university committees, scholarship, contributing to the School of Business curriculum, and promoting and recruiting accounting majors into the MAC program.

The Department encourages applications from candidates with a Ph.D. or DBA in Accounting, experience in the accounting profession (preferred), CPA certification (preferred), experience teaching at the college or university level (preferred), and an active research program.

The Search Committee will begin its formal review of candidates immediately and will continue its review until the position is filled.
