Financial Update:

- There is \$82,000 in the fund now. \$81,000 is earmarked for Teacher Productivity and Americorp Employees. Due to a TA transitioning to a new assignment, we have the \$5,000 from her 3.9 hr position that won't be used. However, we may be short on productivity for teachers due to their pay raise from last year. So we will keep the \$5,000 in the funds to review in 2nd semester after we know which teachers will be on productivity.
- Expenditures:
 - An additional laptop cart was purchased.
 - 13 teachers were in attendance at a PLC conference in SLC.

Academic Update:

Preliminary 1st term data

- This data is preliminary due to teachers offering students a few more days to complete work, show understanding and completion of curriculum requirements. As students make that up, I's and F's can be changed to a better letter grade. If requirements aren't met, those I's turn to F's in the system and we try and work on the credit recovery for the student. We want learning to happen and the student can demonstrate their learning even if it's past the term the initial assessment was given.
- Tyler has a break down of first term data and attendance that he will review with anyone interested.
- We have a goal to make sure we aren't sending students on to high school credit deficient. When a student fails, the teachers mark what standards the students failed so we know where they need to focus to show learning.

Counseling Department Items:

8 grade CCR's are being done. They are also picking out their courses for next year.

Christmas Child Spree: There is \$150.00/child for purchases on Amazon. There are 100 students on the list. The foundation is covering 75. So we are looking for more donors to take care of the 25 not covered yet.

After School Program:

This program is running really well. We have a few new leaders and they are excited and trying new processes to give the students the best enrichment opportunities. Those new teachers also went to Jump Start training.

Library: Ann Riding

VEX IQ: 3 teams and they are participating in league play over at North Layton Jr. They are currently ranked 13th, 16th and 18th. The final league play will be on 11/21 and that will determine who goes to state. Did not get fully funded, so they are looking for donors.

Girls Who Code: received VR headsets. They are working in Co-Spaces to design 3D animation scenes. They will be able to participate in a virtual meeting to talk to an Engineer that National set up.

Library is busy, circulation of about 100 books/day.

During lunch the library is packed with students playing chess, learning how to code and use the robots and checking out books.
