Financial Update: Tyler Poll

- All of the remaining money (\$72,000) for Land Trust are encumbered at this point.
- Will need to review in February meeting.

Academic Update:

- 1st term data
 - 3.14 average GPA
 - More F's this term. Most of these F's were due to lack of attendance.
 - Most F's were 9th grade, elective classes.
 - All of these students have a plan for help and improvement through the counseling center.
 - Hoping the C, B, A Before the Holidays party will continue to incentivize students to improve grades before the holiday break. 356 students currently qualify and we are hoping to see all the students raise their grades so all can attend.
 - The majority of our 9th grade students are having their needs met and through the SIP we are working with those who need different accommodations to evaluate what they know, what they need to know and how we can provide that learning.

Counseling Department Items:

- Doing CCR's with 8th graders.
- There is better parent turn out this year.
- Child Spree:
 - 150 students requested. There is funding for 100. Checking for more resources to cover the other 50 students.
 - Public can donate funds through the Amazon Link that was posted on the Facebook page under the names Jack Frost and Donnor.
 - Other jr high and high schools in the district that Tyler has contacted will also help with our needs.

After School Program:

- Play auditions have started. The play will be Spam-A-Lot.

- Ms. Scott and Mrs. Polland will be overseeing the play.
- There are positions still available to come help students succeed in this program.
- After school tutoring is going well. We need that to be utilized more.

PTA:

- Needs volunteers
- Next event will be a luncheon served to the teachers before parent conferences on 2/13.

Library:

- RF Code week: Students are learning to code Sphero Robots and digital breakout

Any other items:
