AP or CE?

	Advanced Placement	Concurrent Enrollment
COST	\$94 per AP test	\$30 one-time application fee + \$5 per credit
PASS RATE	Need to pass AP test with 3 or better to earn college credit (depends on university)	Need a C or better to earn college credit
RISK	If student fails, the class is NOT recorded on college transcript	If student fails, the class and grades ARE on college transcript
FOCUS	Help students get a head start in college through a rigorous classroom experience	Help students get a head start in college by earning college credit and learning college processes

CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION

Students that receive the General Education Certificate of Completion from Weber State can present it to any State of Utah public college or university and students to have the required general education classes waived at that school.

- Students must pass all AP exams with a 3, 4, or 5 to earn credit and those credits must be submitted to Weber State.
- Any transfer credits would need to be submitted to Weber State.

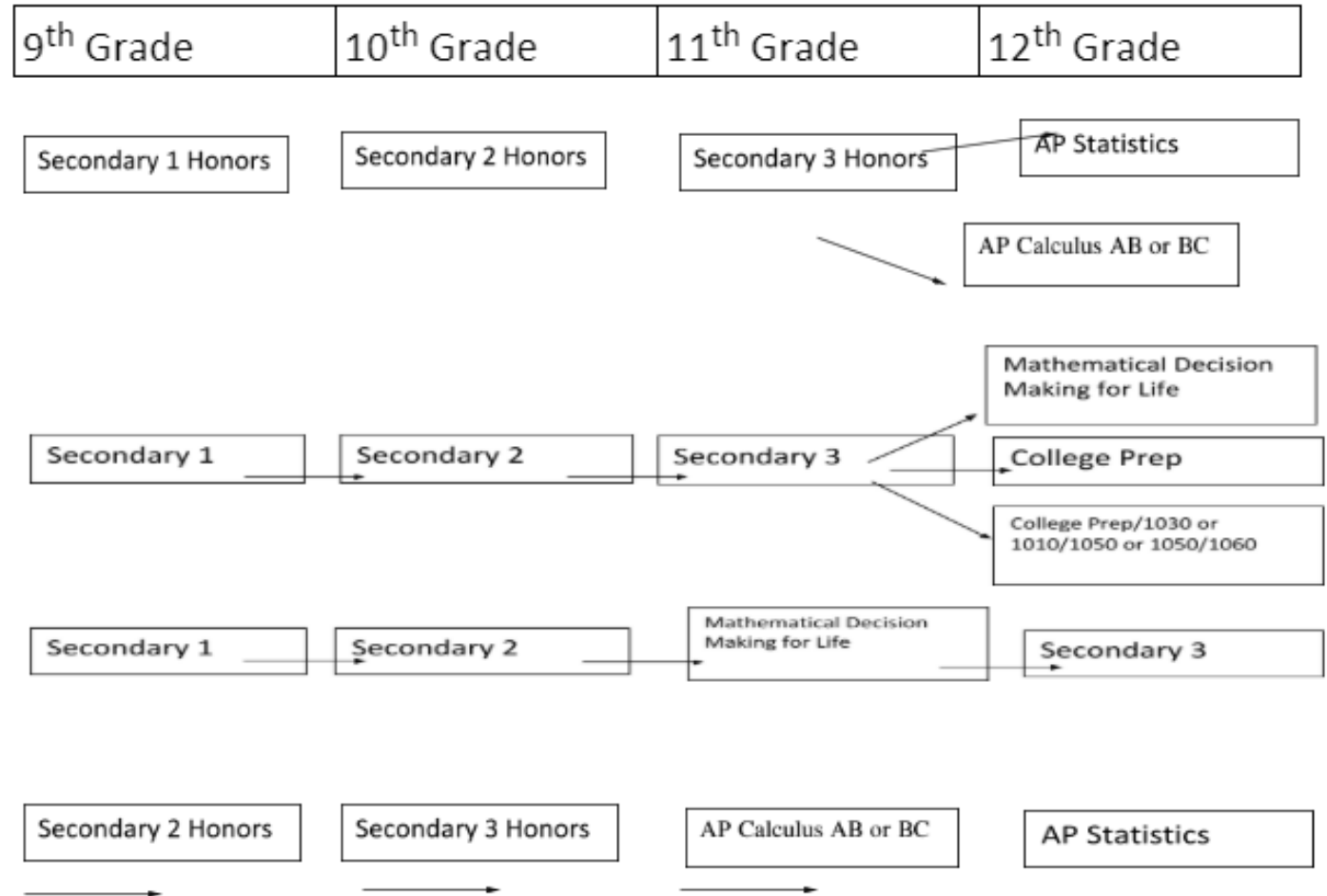
