Ideas for making own puppets: use paper bag, popsicle sticks



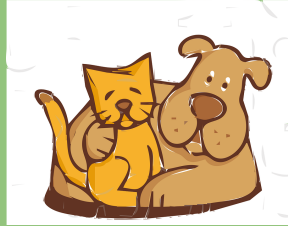
Spend 10 minutes on a computer practicing matching letters or listening to a story.
