- Read or listen to each section of information.



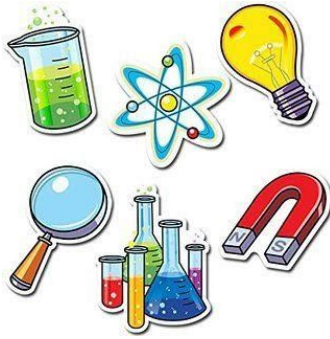
