Reading	Focus on the new information you learn about while reading: Read Carlsbad Caverns . Answer the questions attached to the article.

Vocabulary	Create a visual representation of a word you learned in this article that could be shared on your classroom word wall. Include the word and a picture that shows the meaning of the word.
Penmanship	Choose an option from the board to practice cursive writing.
Science	Continue your study of sound by creating speakers out of balloons .
Math	Complete the math practice page . Practice your math facts. You can self assess using the multiplication math check .

Reading	<p>Focus on character development throughout the story: Choose a fiction reading book of your choice. Pay attention to how characters grow within the text.</p> <p>Print or create your own comprehension cards. Stop and reflect, using the cards, on your reading comprehension. Practice your reading fluency with the fluency cards.</p>
Writing	Write about an activity that you want to learn to do. What makes you interested?
Spelling	Practice spelling and vocabulary on Spelling City .

Science	Go onto code.org and learn to code.

Reading	Focus on why an author chooses specific text features: Choose a nonfiction reading book. Look for examples of text features . Use this chart to fill in examples of text features that you find within your own book.
Writing	Write an opinion piece on a place you recommend someone visit. Explain your opinion on why someone should visit by providing reasons and supporting examples. Use the rubric to help you improve your writing.
Spelling	Practice spelling on Spelling City .
Vocabulary	Strategy: Look for word choices that you know are not correct. Cross them off before looking for a correct word. Words and Their Meaning
Penmanship	Choose an option from the board to practice cursive writing.
Science	How healthy are your lungs ?
Math	Create a math game to play with a friend or family member. It can be related to any math concept we have learned about this year. Use https://xtramath.org/#/home/index to practice your math facts.

Reading	Focus on making a claim and backing it up with evidence from the text: Read Rhino Rescue . Write a reading response in which you make a claim and back it up with evidence from the text. In this case, write a quick argument in response to this question: "What's an important idea this text teaches, and what are at least two pieces of evidence from the text that support this idea?"
Writing	Write a flash draft story with an animal as the main character. Use the writing rubric to identify an area where you can improve your story.
Spelling	Practice spelling and vocabulary on Spelling City .
Vocabulary	A synonym is a word that means the same as another word. Practice matching synonyms here . Strategy: Match answers you know first and then return to unknown answers.

Science	Continue your study of motion by experimenting with the transfer of energy .
Math	Complete the math practice page . Practice your math facts. You can self assess using the multiplication math check .

Reading	Focus on making a claim and backing it up with evidence from the text: Read The Rhino Road Stop . Write a quick response to: What is one important theme (or life lesson) this passage suggests, and where are there places in the story where that theme is visible?
Writing	Continue working on your story from day 2.
Spelling	Practice spelling and vocabulary on Spelling City .
Penmanship	Choose an option from the board to practice cursive writing.
Science	Learn about the different types of machines . Experiment with designing and building the various types of simple machines. How can each machine be used to make a job easier?
Social Studies/Library	Use Britannica to search historical figures. What information can you find that tells about the historical figures of Suffield or Connecticut.
Math	Play Math Tic Tac Toe . Challenge: fill the whole card! Practice your math facts. You can self assess using the multiplication math check .
Physical Education	Complete the physical fitness challenge over the course of each day.

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Day 6

Reading	Focus on what new information is added to what you already know: Read about Allergies . Answer the questions that go with the passage.
Writing	Write about something that is frustrating to you. What strategies do you use when you're feeling frustrated or upset?
Spelling	Practice spelling and vocabulary on Spelling City .
Penmanship	Choose an option from the board to practice cursive writing.
Science	Study the creation of tornadoes by creating a tornado in a bottle .
Math	Complete a math practice page . Play a game on https://www.coolmath4kids.com/
Library	Use Britannica to practice using a keyword search. What did you learn About? Find and record a few new facts to share with a friend.
Physical Education	Complete the physical fitness challenge over the course of each day.

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Day 7

Reading	Focus on answering questions by referring explicitly to the text: Read Dino Express and answer the questions about the text.
Writing	Create a short children's book about the job of a paleontologist. Use information from Dino Express to help you.
Spelling	Practice spelling and vocabulary on Spelling City .
Penmanship	Use your login and password to practice typing. https://www.typetolearn.com/login/index.php
Science	Go onto code.org and learn to code.
Math	Review how to compare the size of fractions . Complete the questions. Try to write your own fraction challenge for your classmates or teacher to solve when you return to school.
Music	Listen to music. Reflect on how you felt when listening to that genre of music.

Reading	Focus on what the big idea of the text is: Read and answer the questions from the passage Clues About the Continents .
Writing	Write about a place you would like to visit and why you want to go there.

Science	Could a volcano pop up where you live? Learn about patterns of Earth's features.
Math	Use the graph paper to sketch a room in your house. Record the area and perimeter of each item in the room.

Reading	<p>Focus on how the text features support your understanding of a text: Read What a Dump. What is the genre of the text? Look for examples of text features. Do a quick jot to answer the questions.</p>
Writing	<p>Create a public service announcement in any form you choose to teach people about the importance of protecting the Earth and wildlife.</p>
Spelling	<p>Practice spelling and vocabulary on Spelling City.</p>
Penmanship	<p>Choose an option from the board to practice cursive writing.</p>
Social Studies	<p>Learn about your local leaders. Your child can write a letter or email to local government leaders.</p>
Math	<p>Analyze the data to answer the questions.</p>
Physical Education	<p>Complete the physical fitness challenge over the course of each day.</p>
