Vocabulary	<p>Create a visual representation of a word you learned in this article that could be shared on your classroom word wall. Include the word and a picture that shows the meaning of the word.</p>
Penmanship	<p>Choose an option from the board to practice cursive writing.</p>
Social Studies	<p>Learn about your local leaders. Your child can write a letter or email to local government leaders.</p>
