Scott Bioren Memorial Scholarship Application

Scott Bioren attended BCS from 2nd grade until his graduation in 1988. He felt a strong attachment to the BCS community as a student and alumnus. He was grateful for the opportunity to be educated at BCS and to benefit from, and to contribute to, the community after graduation. He had a particular fondness for the BCS soccer program both as a player (elected captain and MVP) and later as a coach leading BCS to two state championships.

On August 16, 1995, while building flight hours by riding in the cockpit of a routine commercial air cargo flight, an uncontrollable fire in the right engine of the aircraft resulted in the downing of the plane and the taking of Scott's life. This scholarship is made possible by the gracious contributions of many people who knew Scott personally and those who desire to help provide financial assistance to students and families who desire a BCS education and have an interest or gifting in soccer or other athletic programs.

- 9-12 Grade Student. Current student, re-enrolled for upcoming school year
- Description of the student's faith journey
- Statement of why student desires a BCS education
- Active participation in BCS or other local athletic team (if unsupported by BCS, eg. swim)
- Academic excellence and work ethic

Application Steps:

- 1. Return this completed form and attach student essay.
- 2. Student essay responding to prompts:
 - How does your faith makes a difference in your life? Who is Jesus Christ to you?
 - How has being part of the BCS community has made a difference in your life? and/or
 - Give an example of your interaction with a classmate that reflects your participation in the BCS community.
 - Tell us what you do to accomplish your academic and other goals.
 - Tell us about your participation on a BCS or other athletic team.

Essay will be no longer than two pages and must follow MLA Handbook (8th ed).

3. One coach recommendation articulating the student's participation and contribution in soccer or other athletic program. Coach Recommendation may be submitted separately but must be submitted by application deadline.

Application deadline is 3:00 pm, April 15 (or the immediate school day following if April 15 falls on a holiday or weekend). Application and recommendation must be received in Finance office by this deadline; application steps must be complete to be considered.
