Lloyd Adler Memorial Scholarship Application

The Lloyd D. Adler Scholarship was established in 1992 by Mr. Adler's widow and son. Mr. Adler was the father of BCS alumnus Bruce Adler, Class of 1961, and grandfather of BCS alumna Laurie Adler, Class of 1989. Mr. Adler was a high school biology teacher and college basketball coach before turning to a career in business.

As founder, president, and chairman of the board of the Wigwam Department Stores, he was able to supply BCS with a variety of donated goods in the early days of the school. He maintained an interest in supporting BCS students who needed tuition assistance and demonstrated Christian character and commitment, as exhibited in service to the school and the larger community.

- 1-12 Grade Student

- Recommendation reflecting Christian character and commitment as exhibited in service to the school and the larger community

Application Steps:

1. Submit application for financial aid. See Financial Aid link under the Admissions tab on the BCS website.
2. Return this completed form and attach student essay.
3. Student essay responding to prompts:
 - How does your faith make a difference in your life? Who is Jesus Christ to you?
 - How has being part of the BCS community made a difference in your life, and/or
 - Give an example of your interaction with a classmate that reflects your participation in the BCS community.
 - Why is Biology (or the sciences, in general) your thing?
 - Tell us how you are involved in service at BCS and in your community.Essay will be no longer than two pages. JH and HS students should follow MLA Handbook (8th ed.). Young children who cannot write can respond to parent asking questions based on the prompts and parent may write the responses.
4. Submit one recommendation from an adult not related to student who can articulate the *student's history of service to the school and/or the community*. Recommendation may be submitted separately but must be submitted by application deadline.

Application deadline is 3:00 pm, April 15 (or the immediate school day following if April 15 falls on a holiday or weekend). Application and recommendation must be received in Finance office by this deadline; application steps must be complete to be considered.
