- Financial need

- Description of the student's faith journey
- Statement of why student desires a BCS education
- Demonstration by student and parents of commitment to the educational therapy program

#### Application Steps:

1. Submit application for financial aid. See Financial Aid link under the Admissions tab on the BCS website.
2. Return this completed form and attach student essay and parent statement.
3. Student essay responding to prompts:
  - How does your faith make a difference in your life? Who is Jesus Christ to you?
  - How has being part of the BCS community made a difference in your life, and/or
  - Give an example of your interaction with a classmate that reflects your participation in the BCS community.
  - Why do you want to participate in SAS? Or, how will participation in SAS help you achieve your personal and academic goals?

Essay will be no longer than two pages. JH and HS students should follow MLA Handbook (8<sup>th</sup> ed). Young children who cannot write can respond to parent asking questions based on the prompts and parent may write the responses.

4. A several paragraph statement from the student's parent(s)/guardian(s) which identifies the reasons that they desire a BCS and SAS education for their student and which articulates their commitment to the SAS program.

Application deadline is 3:00 pm, April 15 (or the immediate school day following if April 15 falls on a holiday or weekend). Application must be received in Finance office by this deadline; application steps must be complete to be considered.
