Read 2 books to your child. Talk about how the stories are the same and/or different.	Read the following story problem: There were 10 pieces of pizza and my friend ate 3. How many pieces of pizza are left? Illustrate the problem using pictures, number sentence, tallies, etc.	Talk with your family about how people do things now compared to how people used to do things long ago. If possible, try to do one of the long ago activities (ex. make butter, eat without a fork, don't watch TV!).	Have someone spell each of the following words to you out loud. Read a book to someone special.	Count to 100 by 1's, 5's and 10's while using movement.	Choose five items in your house and put them in order according to how heavy they feel (lightest to heaviest). Do this two times with different objects each time.	Practice reading and writing the color words in a fun way (markers, pens, sand, flour, snow).
