The first thing is to create a manageable list of goals. Having kids look at specific areas within their day in which they would like to improve can help create areas of focus. One area of focus can be socially! Students can work on being better listeners, not talking about their friends, sitting with someone new at lunch or playing a new sport at recess can help meet this goal. Asking a student to talk more in class may cause additional, unnecessary anxiety. However, setting a goal of asking 3 questions a day is a measurable and reasonable goal in the area of academics. Being a better citizen is also an easy area of growth for students. Kids can focus on helping picking up trash and toys without being asked around campus, or even in your own home! Opening the door for others, offering their seat to people who need one, and asking how they can be helpful are other ways to support growth in the area of positive citizenship. 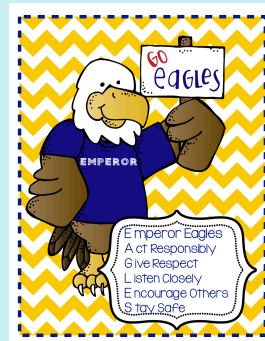
