Math -Work on pages related to multiplying fractions

Have your students notice kitchen items with measurement units on them and measure items around the house using both the US customary units (feet, inches, ounces, cups, pints, quarts, gallons) and metric units (centimeters, meters, liters, milliliters, kilograms)

At the end of the week, write a letter to me about your reading with the following format:

Paragraph 1 - Summarize the part of the book you read for the week. Be sure to state the title of the book and the author's name in your summary paragraph.

Paragraph 2 - Tell about an important character in your story. Describe a personality trait of that character and give examples from the text to support that trait.
