

Monday, March 16, 2020 Plans

Reading: Read pgs. 135-146 (Chapters 21-22) of *Freak the Mighty*. Fill out your reading log and complete one jot using one of the frames from your reading notebooks.

Writing: Repetition is a “tool” that helps the poet to emphasize a feeling or idea and create rhythm in a poem. This is the first “tool” that you can use when writing your own poetry. We will teach you more tools each week that you can use when writing poems. Read the “Still I Rise” poem. It is the last poem in your poem packet. Highlight the repetition that you notice. Then write a poem using repetition.

History: Take a look at the picture of the Ancient Greece Input Chart. The picture is posted in the 6th grade Homework and Announcements. Take out a white piece of paper and set it up for a Learn and Sketch. Write out 5 sentences using the information on the chart showing what you learned. The information can come from any part of the chart. 3 of the 5 sentences need to be compound sentences. Example of a compound sentence: “ Eighty percent of the land in Ancient Greece was rugged mountains and hills, so farming was difficult.” Draw five sketches that go along with your sentences. Teach your Learn and Sketch to your parents and get it signed.
