Course Descriptions

YR= Year Long SEM= Semester

Performing Arts

2301	Choir I/Music Exploration (SEM): Music exploration is a choral singing class combined with general music. Students spend their time in this semester course exploring musical concepts like note values, pitch, rhythm, and music connections. Evening performances required. <i>Can be taken full-year.</i>
2201	Beginning Band 1A (YR): Students will be placed in a percussion/brass or woodwinds class and need to provide/rent their own instrument and plan to attend summer band camp. Evening performances required.
2213	Band-Percussion (YR): Audition required. Students will need to provide/rent their own instrument. Evening performances required.
2405	Orchestra I (YR): Beginning Orchestra. Students will need to provide/rent their own instrument. Evening performances required.
4230	Beginning Theater (SEM): Students focus on creating, performing, responding, and connecting by learning basic theatre concepts and techniques. Preference is given to 8th and 9th graders.

Visual Arts

2101	Art Foundations (SEM): Beginning art class. Focus on Art Elements (fees required).
2103	Adv. Foundation 2D Art (SEM): Prerequisite Art Foundations. Building upon prior knowledge gained in Art Foundations. Preference given to 8th and 9th graders (fees required).
2104	Adv. Foundation 3D Art (SEM): Prerequisite Art Foundations. Building upon prior knowledge gained in Art Foundations. Preference given to 8th and 9th graders (fees required).

Career & Technical Education

7552	Keyboarding (SEM): Students master computer keyboard skills and basic word processing functions. <i>This class is highly recommended for students typing less than 35 words per minute.</i>
7403	FCS Exploration Intro (SEM): Students develop skills in food and nutrition sciences, interior design, and clothing construction (fees required).
7810	Exploring Technology I (SEM): Students apply engineering principles through hands-on activities by constructing and manufacturing (fees required).
7743	Creative Coding (SEM): An introductory computer programming course with learning activities in Computational Thinking, Collaboration, Computing Practice and Programming, Computer and Communication Devices, and Community, Global, and Ethical Impacts. Emphasis on iOS code.

Other Electives

3110	Spanish I (YR): World Language class that begins with the basics of the Spanish language. Preference given to 8th and 9th graders.
3410	German I (YR): World Language class that begins with the basics of the German language. Preference given to 8th and 9th graders.
4335	Creative Writing (SEM): Students develop a variety of approaches to writing prose, poetry, and short stories. Preference given to 8th and 9th graders.
4532	Civics (SEM): Focus on the principles, functions, and organization of government; the origins of American Political System; the roles, rights, and responsibilities of a United States citizens.

Musical Theatre Productions (SEM): Students engage in a complete theatrical experience by participating in a production. Rehearsals and evening performances required.
