Update on Coronavirus

Dear parents and guardians,

As announced earlier, school management and the Board convened this afternoon to re-assess the situation relating to the Coronavirus.

After careful consideration and exchange with all groups of our school community and in alignment with the German Embassy we have decided that the school will be closed for regular on-site teaching from Wednesday 18 March 2020 until further notice. Tuition will continue remotely in line with the contingency plan that has been developed over the past weeks.

Please note the school will be open tomorrow Tuesday 17 March. Important information on how to manage the transition to remote learning will be provided to students during class, tomorrow. So, it is important that all children attend (unless excused for the usual reasons).

This measure has become necessary in the face of operational issues resulting from the current circumstances. Please note that our closure is not required by Public Health England.

Further communication with details of the programme that will be put in place to cover the remaining school days until the Easter break will be follow in the course of tomorrow.

We are confident that together with our community, we will be able to tackle the various challenges that lie ahead of us.
