As a reminder, students will have the opportunity to obtain grab-bag breakfasts and lunches on March 17 from 8:00 am to 10:00 am at the middle school or high school. Those interested will pick up their breakfasts and lunches for the week. The opportunity will again be offered on March 23. The meals will be provided throughout the school closure to ensure our students have the energy and nutrients they need to learn.

Additionally, students and family members may access technology support at the middle school or high school on March 17 from 10:00 am to 12:00 noon. These services will again be offered on March 20 from 10:00 am to 12:00 noon. Please email blaccountinfo@boyslatin.org in advance with the student's name and grade level if you need this support. Our IT team will be available to assist with technology access and Chromebooks.

Lastly, please note that access to our buildings will be significantly limited over the course of the next two weeks. All school and after-school activities are temporarily postponed. We are prioritizing keeping the buildings sanitized and ready for the return of students and staff in the near future. We appreciate your cooperation as we work to support students while limiting access to the facilities.

We are here for you and your son during these two weeks. We thank you for your patience and understanding as we navigate these challenges together. Our focus will remain on serving our students and our community.
