

We compiled a list of computer programs and apps that we will be using during the next two weeks. On Wednesday, we will send out the schedule for you to follow with your child. During the next two days, please familiarize yourself with the programs below. Because this is Kindergarten, many of these will be parent directed. Some of the things your child will be able to do on their own. We know this is a lot to take in. We are learning along with you. Please feel free to email or call us with any questions. Additionally, if you do not have your child's QR code or login information, let us know right away. This is the same information needed to login to Waterford and ST Math.

Attendance will be recorded daily. We will monitor Waterford, ST Math, Epic, and McGraw-Hill to look for completion. Additionally, we will have students send writing papers to us. Below, you will learn about Office Lens that will make this easy to do.

Apps and computer programs we will be using:

English Language Arts:

Waterford: Waterford is a Language Arts app that we use in class and many of you already use at home. You can access Waterford through Clever. You will need your QR code that was given to you at the beginning of the year. If you do not have it, please let me know and I will get you one. Waterford is required 15 minutes each day.

McGraw-Hill: We will be sending you specific assignments each day. McGraw-Hill will help teach comprehension, fluency, reading and phonics. You will need to turn off your pop-up blocker in the safari settings. (Settings, safari, toggle off, block pop ups)

You will access through Clever: (Clever, McGraw Hill, Wonders Grade K Student Addition)

Heggerty: This is our Phonemic Awareness program. This will be all parent driven. Each week there will be a new calendar that you will follow to teach your child.
