2. Log into Google Drive and Google Slides


a. Google Drive

- After you type in the username, you will need to add the “@nb27.org” to the end of it (Ex. Adam1234@nb27.org)
- Enter the password
- In order to complete the installation, a passcode needs to be installed on the mobile phone or tablet.

b. Google Slides

- Because you're logged in on Google Drive, you could continue to login as the account or select another account.
- Choose Continue As.....
- Now you're logged into Google Slides

3. In the Slides app, if you don't see the daily lesson or exit slip, click on the three lines in the top left corner to navigate to “Shared with Me”. The Grade leveled folder is where all of the E-Learning lesson plans will be.
