



Visitor Policy and the Coronavirus (COVID19)

Pocklington School is asking for the support of all those who visit the school site in minimising the risk of COVID-19 to its community.

Our policy has been informed by the directives and guidance given by Public Health England (PHE), the Boarding Schools' Association (BSA) and supported by our in-house medical team.

We ask that any visitors to the school site, be it parents, contractors, speakers or visiting staff read the following:

All visitors are politely asked to refrain from entering the school site for any reason if you have developed the following symptoms in the last 7 seven days. If a member of your household has developed these symptoms, please do not enter the school site unless you have fulfilled the 14 day self-isolation direction given by Public Health England and NHS:

- **Either:** a high temperature (above 37.8 degrees)
- **Or:** a new, continuous cough

NHS guidance:

if you have symptoms, stay at home for 7 days

if you live with other people, they should stay at home for 14 days from the day the first person got symptoms.

We ask that you follow the following steps while on site:

- Wash your hands with soap & water at regular intervals
- Use the hand gel provided around school on entering and leaving the premises
- Cough into your elbow/sleeve
- Please dispose of all used tissues into a bin
