## Pope John Paul II High School Online Educational Plan

## Dear JPII Community,

We hope you have been safe and are enjoying your well-deserved Spring Break. We remain a community committed to supporting the learning of students while taking necessary precautions against the Covid-19. In balancing out these goals of academic progress with student safety, we will resume online courses on Tuesday, March 24. Regular communication with our JPII community will remain a priority in the coming weeks. The expectation is that students will be "attending" 50 minute online courses during the morning while using the afternoon to complete assignments. This plan will ensure that students continue to make academic progress and maintain a schedule that will allow us to hit the ground running when we return to classes on campus. Google Classroom will be the primary way teachers provide learning activities. Graded assignments, as well as due dates, will be posted on Veracross, so expectations are clear for students and families.

We are using a tiered approach for course scheduling. During the first week, March 24-27, we are prioritizing those courses where we have less control of curricular choices since they directly affect ACT, dual enrollment, or Advanced Placement scores that play a role in the college admissions process. The purpose of this prioritization is not to suggest that all courses are not important to JPII's holistic education. Instead, we anticipate that some in our community might experience technical issues, and we want to provide time and flexibility for those students to work through those issues during the class periods that do not "meet" during the first week. If these classes are able to successfully "meet," students will begin meeting with all of their courses except the Innov8 period during the week of March 30-April 3.
