

In our commitment keeping everyone updated on what's happening during school closures due to the coronavirus pandemic, please see our 2nd daily update.

Personal Items Left at School

Did your child leave something at school last week like a piece of clothing, notebook, or musical instrument?

As each of our schools is a unique learning community, building staff are working on plans for allowing parents and students to safely retrieve their personal belongings left at school. An announcement will be made on Monday, March 23 about the date and time each school will be open for this purpose.

Daycare

Daycare for healthcare workers and first responders will be announced tomorrow, Wednesday March 18.

SecURLy

Peninsula School District has a technology system called SecURLy that gives notice when students search for or access information online that may be harmful to themselves or others. For the past year and a half, these notices have gone to counselors and administrators to follow up on with students and parents or guardians.

Due to the district closure until April 27, SecURLy email notifications to district staff will be halted as of today, March 17, 2020. However, as a parent, you have the ability to monitor your child's activity through the SecURLy mobile parent application. You can download the app from the Apple App store or the Google Play Store. You

can also find more information on SecURLy.com. SecURLy.com is also the place to go for questions around this application as they do not provide us tools to assist parents.

Advanced Placement
