ISZL Educational Technology Vision

We embrace technology as a crucial tool for teaching, learning and inquiring that empowers students to think critically and creatively, to collaborate and communicate, thereby supporting the ISZL Mission statement in promoting academic achievement and preparing students to thrive in a global society.

Being a Digital Citizen

At ISZL we use information and educational technology in age-appropriately safe, legal and responsible ways. We embrace the following facets of being a digital citizen:

Respect Yourself:	I will consider the information and images that I post online. I will use appropriate online names.
Protect Yourself:	I will not publish my personal details, contact details, or a schedule of my activities. I will protect my passwords and accounts.
Respect Others:	I will not use technologies to bully or tease other people.
Protect Others:	I will protect others by reporting abuse and not forwarding inappropriate materials or communications.
Respect Intellectual Property:	I will suitably cite all use of websites, books and other media. I will use licensed software and media. I will not use the ISZL logo in unofficial or unauthorised ways

As an ISZL student:

- I understand and will follow the above expectations of responsible use.
- I understand that my school network, e-mail and other school supplied accounts, services and equipment are owned by ISZL and that the use of such services or equipment must be in line with the expectations set out in the ISZL Code of Conduct.
- I understand that ISZL has the right to store student data. In cases where there is specific suspicion of unacceptable student behaviour, as defined in the Student Expectations pages of the ISZL Code of Conduct, ISZL has the right to view the personal data of students concerned.

Sharing Policy for Students

The spirit of technology education is one of sharing and collaboration. We create and use blogs, portfolio tools (e.g. SeeSaw and Blogger), podcasts, videos, wikis, and other social media to share our learning. We use these tools along with our ISZL Schoology Environment, our ISZL Google Suite for Education accounts and other moderated sites approved by school administrators in consultation with the educational technology coaches, to allow students to collaborate and interact online with teacher supervision.
