

# Remote learning protocols

## **Expectations for students in Lower School**

### Setting up a work space:

- Find a quiet space- You can use a sign saying "School in Session"
- Let people know what you are doing and for how long
- Remove distractions- Ask for what you need (turn off phone, family members quiet, pets outside, TV off, etc...)
- Have materials (supplies, notebooks etc) nearby
- Device charged or plugged in

## **Group norms for positive digital learning:**

- Make a plan for your workload
- Stay on task without getting distracted: no texting or G chatting
- Be on time if you are meeting as a group
- Inform class or peers if you need to step away during collaborative work
- Make positive comments or disagree respectfully (avoid sarcasm or jokes)
- Keep the focus on learning
- Ask questions when you don't understand

#### Attendance:

Join Seesaw every weekday and follow instructions from teachers. This is how we will take attendance. Expect work every day.

Complete the tasks that your teachers request. Turn in work that needs to be turned in. Meet every time you are supposed to meet .

You will have some freedom as to when you complete the work, however you are expected to follow instructions and complete required work by the deadline (day and time), whether it is participation in a discussion or completion of a set of exercises or completion of a written piece, or recording of an oral piece.
