Dear Ansonia Families,

The distribution of chromebooks for ELEMENTARY STUDENTS will take place tomorrow, Thursday, March 19, 2020 at Mead School and Prendergast School. **The chromebooks are for students who do not have a desktop computer or laptop/tablet at home.** If you have sufficient technology for your children, you do not need to pick up a chromebook.

The pick-up times at Mead and Prendergast will be between the hours of 8-11 a.m. or 3-6 p.m. You will be required to sign a form as part of the distribution. Please know that all of the equipment has been disinfected.

Our instructional leaders have been working on online learning plans for all students in Ansonia Public Schools. Our goal is to have the online learning plans finalized and ready to be used by students from home by Monday, March 23.

**For the mobile food distribution program that began today, we have made some changes to the times and routes below.** The program will continue to operate Monday-Friday until further notice. Any child ages 18 and under or their parent/guardian may go to one of the bus stops below for a lunch and next day breakfast meal. No identification is required to receive these meals. Each bus below will have its designated number visible. Please note that all four buses will leave Ansonia High School at 11 a.m. each day, and the drop off times listed below are approximate.
