



How Distance Learning will work at BHHS:

- Teacher information sheets that contain the class assignment submission days, Google Classroom code, Zoom meeting number, and virtual office hours will be sent to you via email and posted in Google Classroom for your student's reference.
- Every teacher will have office hours for a **minimum** of one hour daily. Teachers will utilize this time to answer questions and check in on students. This may be done through email or live Zoom meetings.
- Google Classroom and Zoom will be the platforms used by teachers to communicate and assign work to your student(s).
- The five core classes (English, Math, Science, Social Studies, and Languages Other Than English- LOTE) will be posting **daily communication** with your student and **one** assignment will be required to be turned in **weekly**. Daily practice could be included as well.
- Elective and CTE courses will be posting **weekly** communication (only once a week) with your student and **one** assignment will be turned in **weekly** as well.
- Lessons will be around 20 minutes in length for on-level courses and 30 minutes for PAP/DC/AP courses.
- Tutorial videos for Google Classroom and Zoom are available in the Student HUB (add link). These can be accessed whenever help is needed.
- Participation in Distance Learning is required for students to earn credit and be promoted to the next grade level. Teachers are tracking participation and will be in weekly contact with the grade level Assistant Principal and Counselor regarding those students who do not participate.
- To help with organization, we have posted two different digital planner templates on the Student HUB for your student(s) and/or family to use during this time.

Attendance

- Attendance documentation is required. An attendance link in your student's third period teacher's google classroom will need to be completed daily. The form will also include questions asking about their social emotional health during this time.

Grades

- Skyward gradebooks will be locked by the district on Friday, March 20. Teachers will use the Google Classroom gradebooks from this point forward.
- All GPA points and class rank have been frozen at the end of the 4th six weeks. The remainder of the six weeks will be recorded as Pass or Fail grades. Students will still be able to average the first and second semester grades to earn credit as long as the student is successfully participating in Distance Learning.
- You may see zeros for any work or tests missed from the first three weeks of the 5th six weeks. **Do not panic**. These zeros will include gradebook notes to be made up when school resumes. In the event that school does not resume, these grades will **NOT** be used due to extenuating circumstances.
