



Story Elements

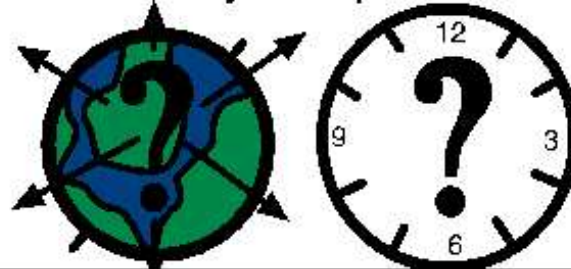


When reading a story, or doing a picture walk identify the characters, setting, problem and ending of the story.

The characters are the people or animals who act out a story.



The setting is where or when a story takes place.



The problem is a struggle or difficulty the characters go through in the story.



The ending tells us how the problem was solved, and how the story ended.



After reading a story or doing a picture walk through a story, identify the characters, setting, problem and ending of the story.

This can be used when watching movies or shows, or even discussing events that you participated in (hopefully there weren't any big problems ©).
