What is the month? What is the day of the week?

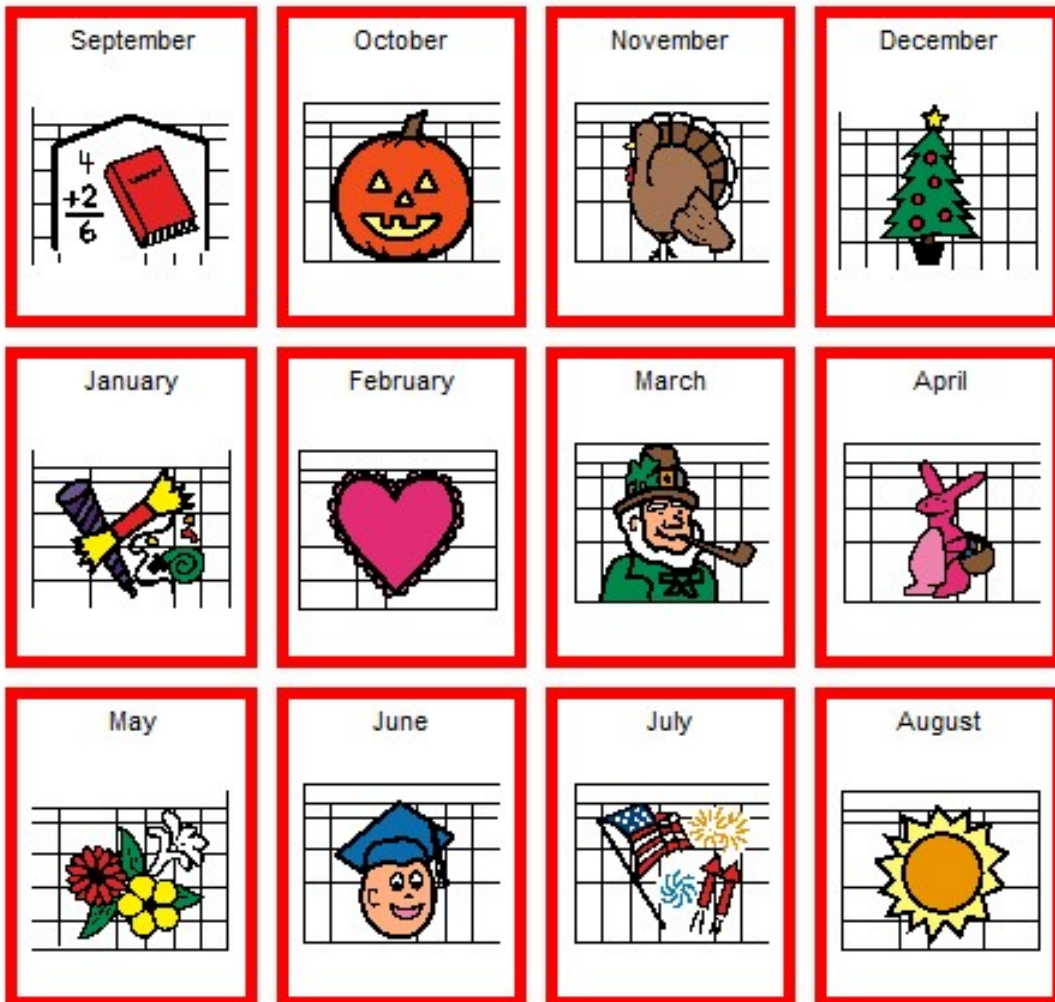

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# Humpty Dumpty

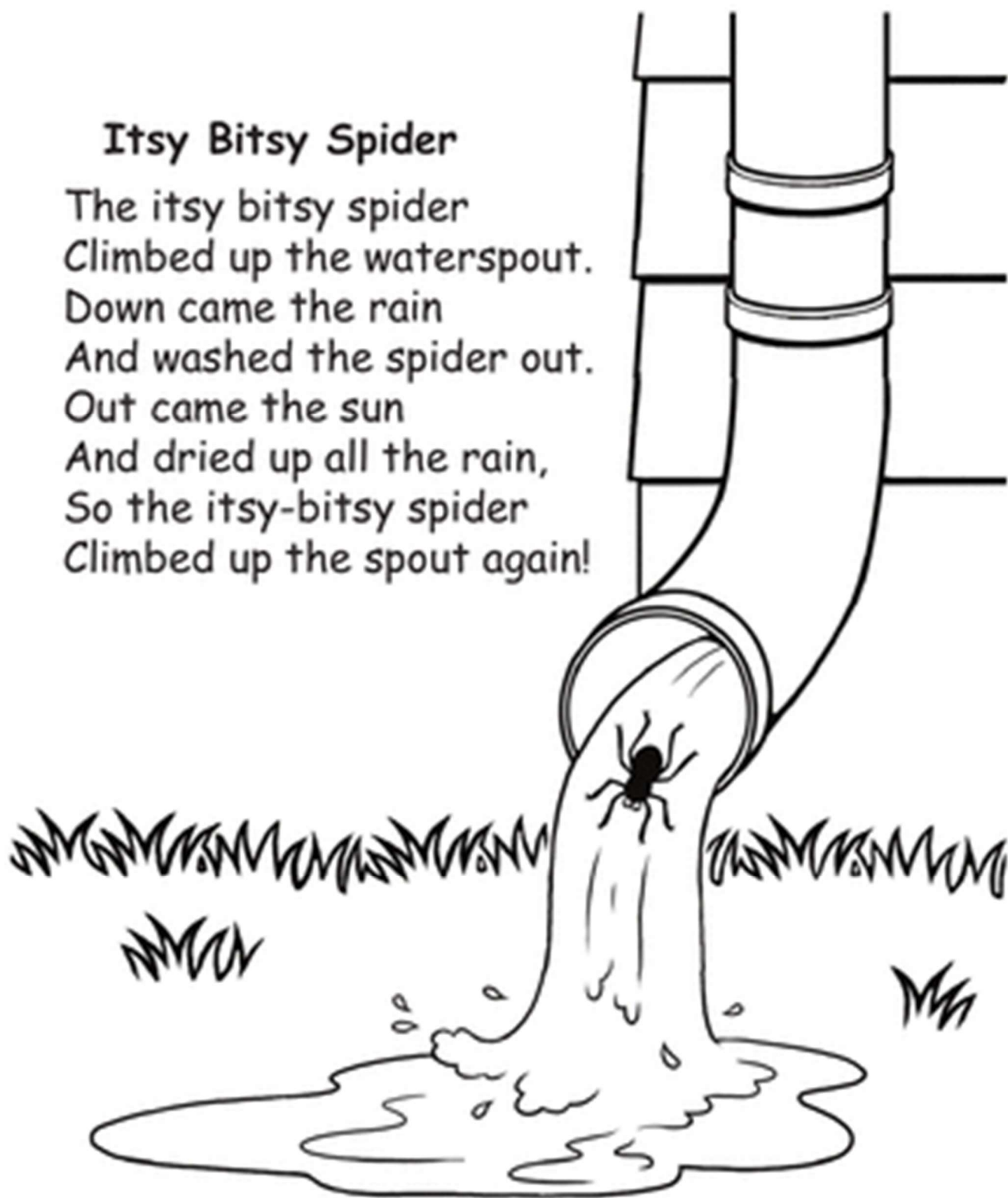
Humpty Dumpty sat on a wall.

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## Itsy Bitsy Spider

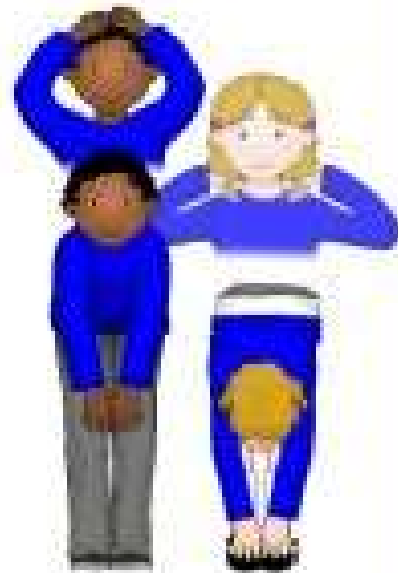
The itsy bitsy spider

Climbed up the spout again!



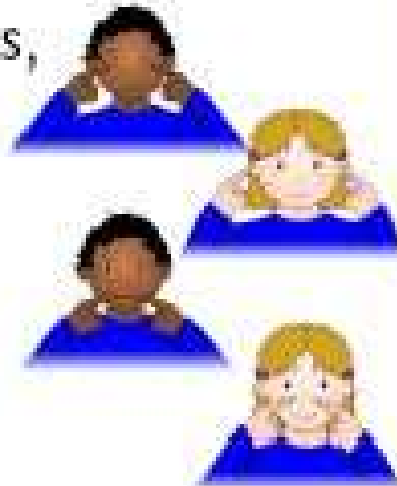
# Movement Activities
