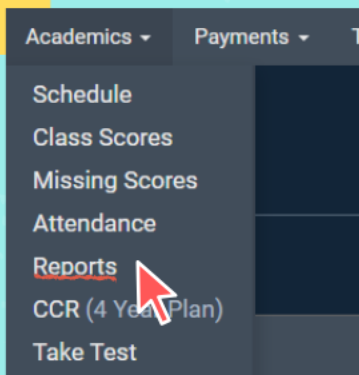
Zone 2 Conservation District Scholarship
