As a reminder, any child of a 129 family, regardless of age, can receive his or her meal from any of the eight distribution centers. <u>Students are not limited to their home buildings</u> or feeder schools.

THE WHAT

School District 129 will host 12 food distribution centers throughout the district during school closures due to COVID-19.

THE WHY

There is no single face of food insecurity, as it impacts <u>every community</u> in the United States. Our responsibility as a community partner is to remove as many barriers as we can for our families.

THE WHO

The children of all SD129 families will be offered breakfast and lunch.

THE WHERE

*Any SD129 child can receive their food from <u>any</u> of the 8 food distribution centers, meaning they are not limited to their home building only.

THE WHEN

Food distribution centers will be open from 9 am - 1 pm, Monday through Friday during the school closures due to COVID-19.

THE HOW

West Aurora will be using the "honor system," meaning that children need not be present for families to receive meals and no school identification is needed. Additionally, two days' worth of meals will be provided per child in an effort to minimize the number of trips a family will need to make.

In order to promote social distancing and reduce the risk of spreading the virus, drivethru service will be available and is strongly recommended. If a family needs to walk to one of our food distribution locations, we recommend that they obey social distancing guidelines and minimize the number of people walking with them. Families are asked to form a car line nearest to the main door except at Jewel Middle School where the drivethru will be held at door 30 (west of main entrance) and at West Aurora High School where it will be held at door 14B (nearest to Veteran's Fieldhouse).

A big "thank you" to our local law enforcement municipalities

who have agreed to lend their assistance in the process!

Please be patient and avoid the hoarding we have seen at our local grocery stores. We will have plenty of food. You do not have to be there at 9 am!
