Athletics

As noted, athletic practices, games and events also continue to be canceled through Tuesday, April 7, 2020, and/or until further notice. We realize that only leaves Wednesday, April 8 before the Easter Break, and we plan to update families as soon as information becomes available.

Spring sports photos and the Spring Collegiate Athletic Signing event have been postponed. Spring athletic fees have been automatically posted to the FACTS system and we advise parents to hold off on paying the fee until IHSA has made a determination about spring sports. If fees have already been paid, refunds can be issued if necessary. We are hopeful that the spring sports season will resume, but we prefer to have families wait to pay assessed athletic fees until a determination has been made. Students are encouraged to engage in physical exercise and resources have been made available to spring student-athletes by Athletic Trainer Grace Eastman.
