Activities to Practice Sight Words at Home

Popsicle Sticks: Write the sight words on popsicle sticks. Write BANG on a couple of sticks. Put them in a jar. Pull them out one by one, read the word. If you pull BANG, you have to put them all back in the jar.

Magnetic Letters: Use magnetic letters to build words.

Sight Word Hunt: Search for and read sight words in magazines, books, newspapers, etc.

Shaving Cream: Write the words in shaving cream on the table.

Flashlight Tag: Find sight words on the wall.

Playdoh: Use playdoh to form the letters and build the sight words.

Legos: Use dry erase markers to write sight words on the side of legos, and place them in a pile. Call out a word, have your child find the lego with that word, and add to the tower.
