

Dear Parent / Guardian,

Please accept our apologies for those who were unable to pick up food this morning. We served 400 meals today, far more than the 96 we had anticipated from the survey results. We actually ran out of food and will be getting a delivery tomorrow in preparation for Wednesday. Now that we have a better sense of the interest in these meals, we are adding an additional pickup day on Fridays. Remember that these meals are available only for the students of the Lyme-Old Lyme Schools. Going forward the meal distribution schedule will be as follows.

On Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 8:30 a.m. - 9:30 a.m. simply drive up to the front of LOLHS and “grab and go” bags will be handed through your car window. Monday’s distributions will include meals for both Monday and Tuesday while Wednesday’s distributions will include meals for Wednesday and Thursday. Friday’s distribution will include meals for Friday only.

As a reminder starting tomorrow, most of our office personnel will be working remotely in an effort to support social distancing. Those who are working remotely will have access to voicemails but will not be able to answer calls directly. As such, should you need to contact us, the best way to do so will be through email.
