Clarifications and Questions from March 12, 2020 Pre-Bid Conference

Question:Per 3.7.1, the contractor shall secure and pay for the building permits and all other permits and fees with
exception to trade permits. Please confirm if the owner will pay for building permit for the project as is typical.

Answer: **Correct, owner will pay for the building permit and contractor is responsible for all trade permits and fees,** including deferred submittal review fees.

- Question: Is the a project estimate available for bid bond procurement purposes?
- Answer: Estimate for the work is \$2,447,000
- Question: Is Controls carried by the mechanical contractor, school district?

Answer: It is not carried by the school district. It will be carried by the mechanical or general contractor.

Question:Would it be possible to waive the AWI cabinet and countertop requirement in specification Architectural Woodwork
06 41 00. It could be very difficult to get the AWI cabinet subcontractors to bid such a small amount of work.Answer:We will not waive the AWI requirement. We need this to ensure quality of the casework.
