



## AMERICAN SCHOOL OF PARIS

### Tuition and fees for School Year 2019-2020

All fees are payable in Euros.

- **Application fee:** **€ 1,360 per child**  
This is a mandatory fee paid at the time of application to the school. It is not refundable even if the child is not accepted at ASP.

- **Annual Tuition:**

<b>Lower School:</b>	K3 (3+ years old)	<b>€ 18,820</b>
	K4 (4+ years old)	<b>€ 25,340</b>
	K5 to Grade 5 (5+ to 10 years old)	<b>€ 30,400</b>

<b>Middle School:</b>	Grades 6 to 8 (11+ to 13 years old)	<b>€ 34,945</b>
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<b>Upper School</b>	Grade 9 to Grade 13 (14+ to 18 years old)	<b>€ 34,730</b>
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- **Capital Assessment:** **€ 11,985 per child**  
One-time fee charged the first year the child attends ASP. The fund is devoted to the upkeep of our buildings, grounds and campus. There is no C.A. fee for the K3 nor K4 programs, so for a child entering at those levels, the fee would not be payable until they enter K5.

- **English as an Additional Language (EAL) fee:** **€ 5,490 per child**  
Paid by children participating in our EAL program of special English instruction for non-native English speakers.

- **Learning Support Services Fees:** **€ 6,695 per child**  
This fee is for participation in our Learning Support Program for students with documented learning needs. Support is delivered through small group and/or individualized content/concept instruction and skill development.

- **Bus fee**

<b>Zone 1 (close to school)</b>	<b>€ 3,600 per child</b>
<b>Zone 2 (other areas)</b>	<b>€ 4,000 per child</b>

This fee is paid by students taking our school buses and entitles them to use our late bus service after extra-curricular activities.

- **Security Fee** **€ 1,680 per child**  
This fee covers the extra security expenses incurred by the school after the events of September 11, 2001 and the heightened vigipirate level of 2015/16, after which ASP has been investing heavily in Security infrastructure and trained personnel.

▪ **Trips**

Educational trips are included in the Tuition Fee if they are an integral part of the curriculum program and have a mandatory attendance .The Tuition Fee is a global amount covering the many programs on offer. Should a trip not take place the relevant funds are reallocated to other educational programs and materials, and hence reimbursements are not possible.
