





La Porte Elementary Specials Outreach Learning March 25 - 27, 2020

Objectives: **Grades k-1:** I will distinguish between high and low sounds in a song. **Grades 2-5:** I will create and perform found sounds.

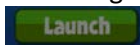
English Language Proficiency Standards: The student is expected to listen to and derive meaning from variety of media such as audio, videos and pictures to build and reinforce concepts and language.

Grades K-1 -On the student dashboard click Assignments. Click “High and Low and Being Polite” tab on left.



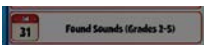

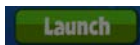
Work your way through the lessons by clicking the instructions tab in the lower left of each screen. As you finish each screen click the arrow to the right. Complete the first 8 screens for this week.

Grades 2-5 -On the student dashboard click Assignments. Click “Found Sounds 2-5”



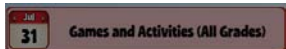
Click the launch tab on the bottom right.
