

**TEMPLE CITY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT  
APPLICATION FOR CITIZENS' OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE**

The Board of Education of the Temple City Unified School District is seeking members to fill open positions on a committee of community leaders which will serve as the independent Citizens' Oversight Committee ("COC") for the District's Measure S school facilities bond program.

**Proposition 39 Bond Election**

On November 6, 2012, voters residing within the Temple City Unified School District passed Measure S. Measure S is a \$128.8 million bond measure that authorizes funding for needed repairs, upgrades, and new construction projects to the District's schools. Proposition 39 required a 55% supermajority for approval; Measure S was passed by over 63%.

**Establishment of a Citizens' Oversight Committee**

After a bond authorized under Proposition 39 is passed, state law requires that the Temple City Unified School District Board of Education appoint a Citizens' Oversight Committee to work with the District.

**Committee Responsibilities**

In accordance with Education Code Section 15278(b), the Citizens' Oversight Committee shall:

- Inform the public concerning the District's expenditure of Measure S bond proceeds;
- Review expenditure reports produced by the District to ensure that Measure S bond proceeds were expended only for the purposes set forth in Measure S; and
- Present to the Board of Education in public session, an annual written report outlining their activities and conclusions regarding the expenditure of Measure S bond proceeds.

**Appointment of Committee Members**

All appointments will be made by the Board of Education from applications submitted to the District.

**Time Commitment and Term**

Each appointee shall serve a two-year term.
