


Cut out the pieces below, and rearrange them to show the cover of a book. Then, glue them onto the book cover on the next page.



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Design your own book cover! Write the title, the name of the person who wrote the words, the name of the person who drew the pictures, and a picture.


Glue the pieces you cut out to the book cover below.



Show this page to a partner, and explain the different parts of the book cover.







Circle the picture where Ray looks very upset.




What does Fay use to solve the problem? Circle it in both pictures.

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Talk about this part of the story with a partner. What do the friends learn?








