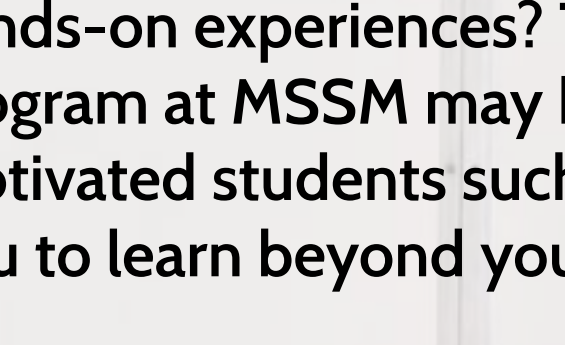

Unique and advantageous partnerships

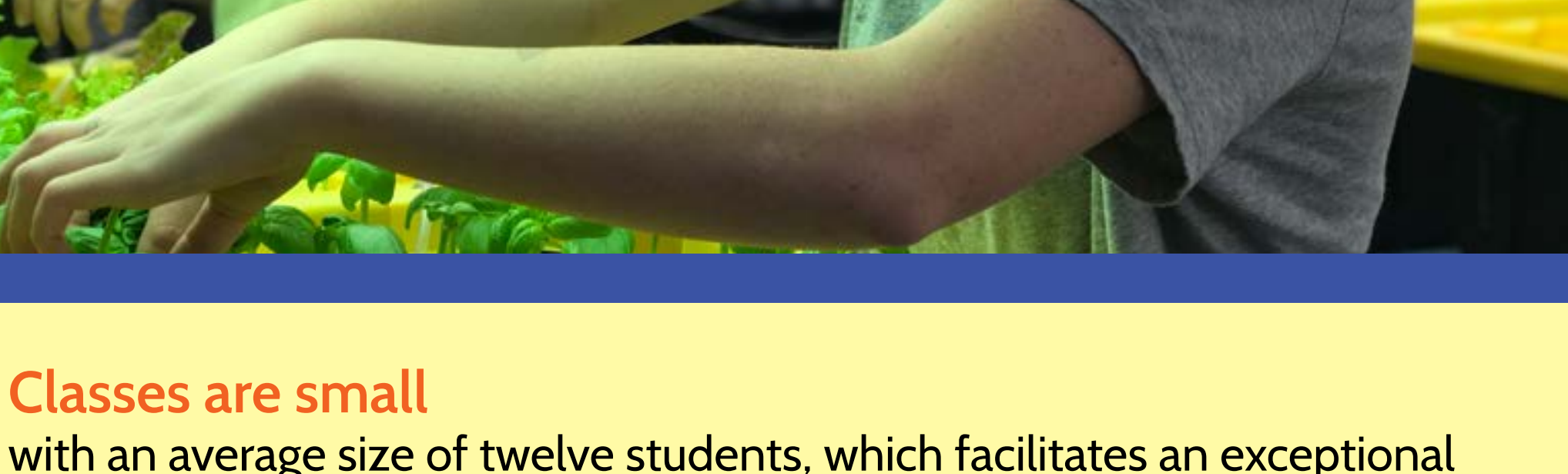
exist between MSSSM and some of Maine's finest research institutions, including the Jackson Laboratory.

Classes are small

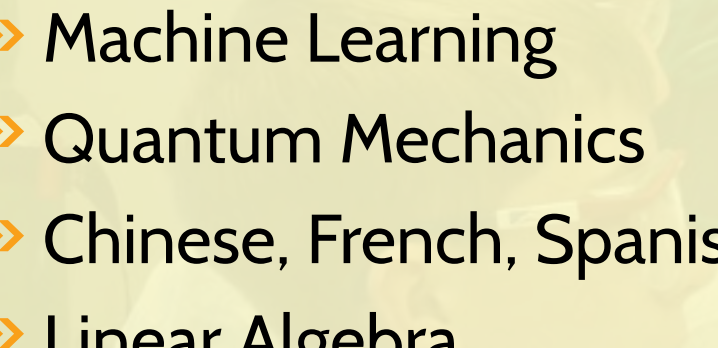
with an average size of twelve students, which facilitates an exceptional degree of faculty-student interaction.

Engaging and knowledgeable faculty

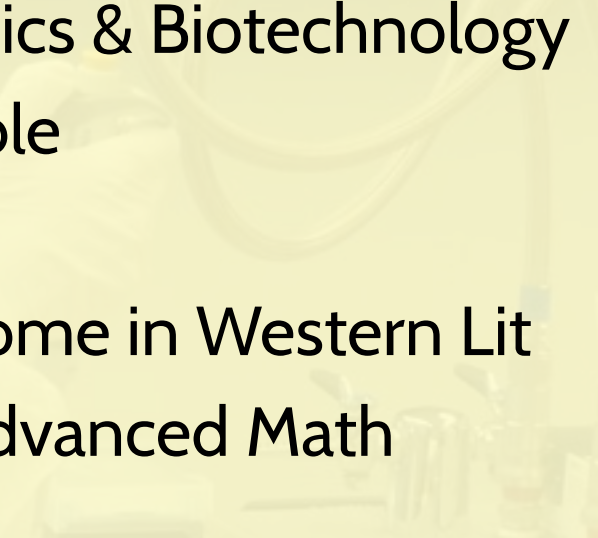
who are specialists in their fields and enthusiastically disseminate information and challenge students to explore the world.

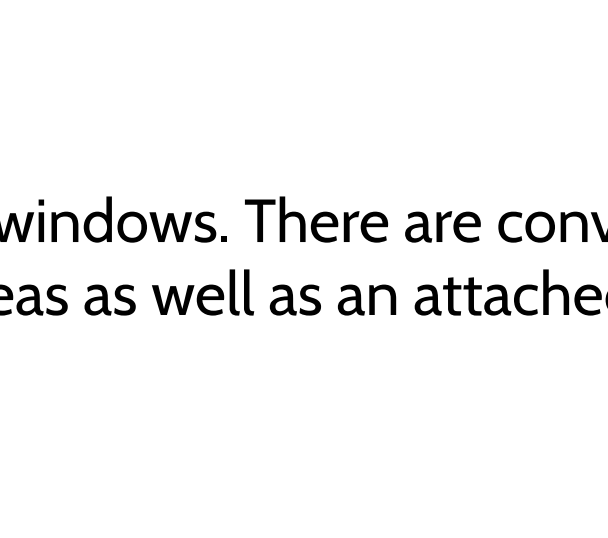

Northern Location Promotes Immersive Experience

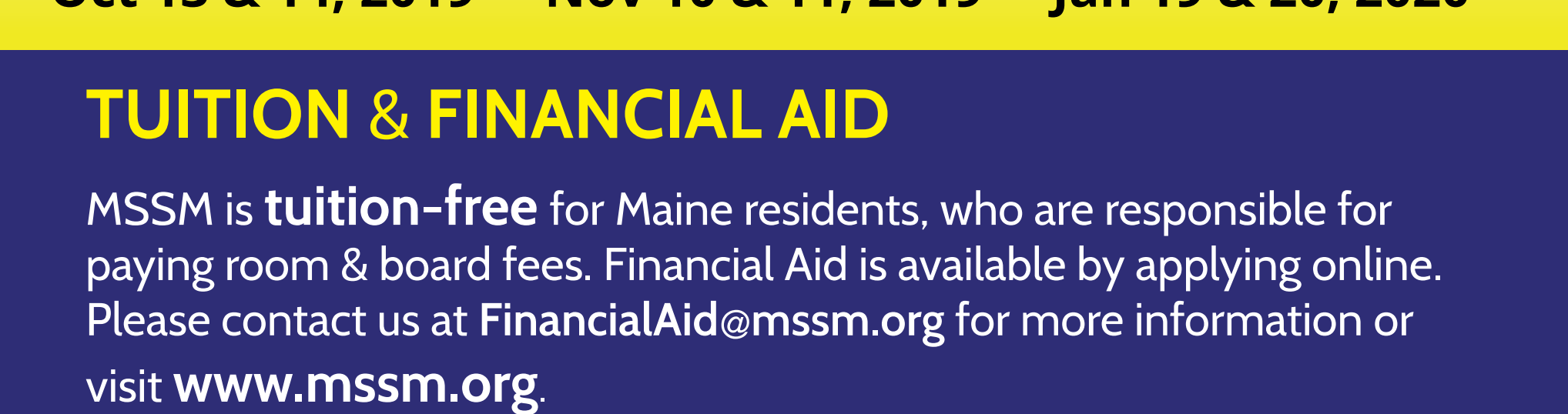
by offering a safe place where students can grow, both academically and socially, and become an integral part of the academic and residential communities.
