A panel of judges will select exceptional pieces through a blind process where all names and schools are removed.

This year's selected pieces will be featured at Five Senses Festival this summer - details TBD.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- **Submission deadline extended to **Thursday, April 30, 2020****

- Writings must be 400 words or less and may include: poetry, short story, short play, or an act from a play.
 - Students in grades K-12 are eligible to submit.
 - Only one entry is allowed per student.
 - Teachers, parents, or students themselves may submit.
 - All submissions must be made electronically at **ASAPCT.ORG**

- **Submissions must be uploaded as a WORD document and must follow the formatting requirements below:**

- Include Name, School, Grade and Title (each on a separate line) in upper left corner
 - Use Times New Roman font in size 12
 - Make sure document is single-spaced with 1" margins
 - File must be named: LastnameFirstname_Title_Grade
ex. SmithBob_Trees_Grade5

Pieces WILL NOT be accepted if they do not follow these guidelines.
