 - David received letter from Bellevue Christian stating the suspension of the Capital Campaign Project
 - The SHS roof project is in process. Soliciting 4 RFP's in January. Work is expected to take place over the next three years.
 - o Positive admissions numbers for Pre-K and Kindergarten
 - Pre-K registration to-date
 - 20 siblings
 - 4 staff children

 - David is working with architect Richard Glassman to develop a 5-10 year Master Plan for SHS
