

Expanded access to JSTOR.

Many online providers are providing free or expanded access to their content. See below for JSTOR's announcement of expanded access to journals and books.

On your portal page at bdc.org, there is a link to the **Library** under **Learning Resources**. (On student portals it's called Classroom Resources.) Click Library and a dropdown menu opens, with links to the Online Public Access Catalog, JSTOR, EBSCO, and a document with the **Database Passwords and Instructions**. Direct students to their portal page to find these resources.

The Library's home page (not behind bdc.org firewall), <https://booksandbeyond.edublogs.org>, has some links to more free content. (Audible has some free audiobooks, no subscription required). Look for material to be added on a regular basis. The right column of the homepage lists lots of resources including database information.
