PREKINDERGARTEN LANGUAGE ARTS

How can I help my child learn at home?

- Read to your child every day.
- Ask your child questions about stories that you read.
- Encourage your child to write for different purposes at home (helping you make a grocery list or writing a thank you letter or card to someone.)
- Have conversations with your child about their experiences in school and in social activities
- Encourage your child to read to you (either by reading the words he/she knows or by telling the story using the pictures)

Questions to ask your child at home?

- What letter would I write first to write the word 'pig'?
- Why do you think the boy is feeling sad in the story? What do you think will happen in the story when...?
- (Pointing to period or question mark when reading) What is this? What does it mean?
- Can you tell me about the picture/story you wrote? Can you sign your name on it?
- What can you tell me about the animals you saw at the zoo?

PREKINDERGARTEN MATH

How can my child learn at home?

- Encourage your child to count different objects in his/her environment.
- Ask your child about his/her day, focusing on what happened before, after, in the morning, after lunch, etc.
- Give your child opportunities to share items evenly between multiple people (cookies, toys, etc)
- Tell your child a simple addition/subtraction story. Allow them to use beans or marshmallows to solve the problem (I bought 4 apples from the store, but Daddy ate 2. How many apples do I have left?)

Questions to ask your child at home?

- How much do the apples cost? What numbers are there?
- Can you count and wash the strawberries for me?
- How high can you count?
- What did you do this morning? What will you do after dinner?
- Can you give me some strawberries so that we have the same number?
- Does an elephant or a dog weigh more?
