

Dear First Grade Families,

We hope you are all well and ready to learn! As a first-grade team we have been creating activities for you to do each week at home.

For this week, we are including math, reading, and a social studies activity.

In math we will be presenting the activity, "How many chairs?" - This is a problem-solving activity where students will work to figure out how many chairs are needed or missing.

In reading and literature, we will be doing a sight word/vowel team search through books your child is reading at home. While reading, students will be hunting for sight words found on their individual word wall as well as vowel teams such as OO, EA, OW, etc. We have also included the link, [storylineonline.net](http://storylineonline.net) where your child can watch professional actors read some of their favorite books. While watching story tellers, look for ways the reader makes the story engaging to the listener. Try some of these skills in your own reading (example: reading with expression - remember, when reading with expression, sometimes we have to reread the story several times).

In social studies we will provide a worksheet where students can write, draw, or discuss their family's culture and traditions.

Along with these resources, remember to also enjoy digital programs like dreambox, RAZ kids, and MyOn.
