

Social Studies Week One:

This week's activity is for you to discover the Coastal Salish tribe of the Pacific Northwest. Included in this activity is a link for a you tube video from discovery kids explaining the culture of the Salish clan. I also have included an Encyclopedia article in case you are not able to open the link. The purpose of this activity to get you thinking about the Coastal Native Americans because when we come back, we will start our social studies unit, this is the first step in our studies.

Your activity:

Step one: Watch the video from the beginning all the way until 19:30. (After 19:30 it goes into Native Americans of today)

Step two: Pick a section in the video such as how they built the canoes and write a summary of the information you have learned.

When writing a summary, write main idea supporting details and make it a paragraph length. There are many sections in this video. If you want to write about more than one, that would be great!
